1. An Applicants who want to withdraw the Land Application for Statutory Right of Occupancy must apply with this WAP form.
2. The Applicant must give a Reason for the Withdrawal and a Date for the Ministry of Lands and Urban Development (MLUD) to close the File
3. The Applicant must give a short description of the Property where the Land Application was open for.
